For example, the cost of a trip is \$20, currently you pay \$10 and the remaining \$10 is paid by the Council. As of 1<sup>st</sup> April, the Government will pay \$15 leaving you only \$5 to pay.

### Easter Egg Wreath

What you'll need:

- # Crepe Paper in different colours
- # Eggs
- # Wire wreath frame
- # Tissue Paper
- # Scissors
- # Hot glue gun
- # Floral wire

1. Cut strips of crepe paper in ½ inch strips
2. Wrap strips around the eggs and glue to secure.
3. Repeat for all the eggs.
4. Use the tissue paper to wrap or fill the wire wreath to give you more surface to attach the eggs to.
5. Arrange your eggs by nestling them into the tissue paper and use hot glue to secure.
6. Instead of crepe paper you can use scraps of brightly coloured fabric or wool. You can also add some greenery if you wish, secure it with floral wire.
